Required Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Application Form • Academic Objectives and Research/Study Plan • Transcript or Certificate of Academic Records from one's home school • Statement of Financial Resources • Certification of financial resources sufficient enough to cover living expenses while staying in Japan • Photocopy of Applicant's Passport (photo page) • <u>Five (5) Color Photos</u> (headshots with no backgrounds; 3 x 4cm) • Application for Certificate of Eligibility (designated form by Japanese Ministry of Justice)
Nomination & Application Deadline	Fall semester: 15 th May Spring semester: 15 th November
Announcement for the Official Acceptance	Fall semester: Mid-June Spring semester: Mid-December

VISA Procedure	<p>Certificate of Eligibility (COE) and Letter of Acceptance will be sent to a home institution with the following schedule. Upon receipt, students need to apply for a student VISA at the nearest Japanese Embassy.
